has been issued vide Govt. Order No. 69-JK(DSD) of 2023, dated 08.06.2023. The claim that "the channel/route for promotion of Drawing Instructor promoted Supervisors as Superintendent ITI is under Category 'b' i.e. 20% to 3 years Diploma in Engg and equivalent with 05 years Experience."

Earlier the qualification of above officials were also challenged in Hon'ble High Court Jammu vide SWP No. 2670/2001 titled Ajay Kumar vs State and others. The Writ Petition was dismissed and found without merit.

Furthermore the seniority of above officials in Seniority list of Drawing Instructors/Supervisors notified in the year 2018 was also challenged by Mr. Bilal Ahmad Wani, Anoop Sharma and others, which too was disposed of by Director Skill Development vide speaking order No. 543 of 2018 dated 10.07.2018.

These incumbents have been considered by the DPC/PSC for regularization to the post of Superintendent as per seniorities issued by DSD from time to time and as per eligibility/placement orders.

Keeping in view the above facts the objections filed by official seems devoid of merit.

Final seniority list of Superintendent ITIs was issued vide Govt. Order No. 54-JK(DSD) of 2023 dated 10-05-2023 wherein myself was shown at S.No 3 and G.M. Bhat and Khan Farooq at S.No. 1 & 2 respectively which was challenged in Hon'ble CAT Jammu in O.A. No 494/2023 and Hon'ble CAT Jammu on 15-05-2023 was pleased to issue interim directions which is reproduced as

Mr. Rajendra Kumar, was appointed as Superintendent ITI, on 05.03.1999.

However, on the recommendations of PSC under communication No. PSC/DPC/ITI/9/93 dated 22.01.2002, Vide Government Order No. 26-Edu(Tech) of 2002 dated 08.02.2002 Mr. G.M Bhat was promoted as Superintendent w.e.f 01.01.1996 under promotion quota on notional basis to restore his seniority in the cadre of Superintendent, so Mr. G.M Bhat Superintendent placed ahead in the seniority list of Superintendents notified in the year 2002 vide Government Order No. 30-Edu(Tech) of 2002 dated 05.03.2002.

The DPC for promotion to the post of Assistant Director/Principal/AAAs held on 04.05.2023 utilized seniority notified in the year 2002 in which among others Mr. Rajindera Kumar has also been regularized as Assistant Director/Principal w.e.f 01.05.2006, so he is not existing in the seniority of Superintendents. .

..... An as interim measure, it is ordered I that pursuant to impugned seniority list dated 10-05-2023 till the next date of hearing, no further steps shall

More so, both the incumbents Mr. G.M Bhat and Mr. Rajindera Kumar have been promoted as Assistant director/Principal on the recommendations of J&K PSC vide Government Order No.66-JK(DSD) of 2023 dated 05.06.2023 (under w.e.f 01.04.2004 and 01.05.2006 respectively. The case file was also referred to the Law Justice & Parliamentary Affairs Department for opinion in the matter. The Law department vide U.O No LAW-Ser2/18/2023-10 dated 11.07.2023 opined as under in

be taken for the purposes of hearing, no further steps shall be taken for the purposes of confirmation of promotion/promotion to the higher post"

Grievances as submitted from time to time be addressed by placing myself above to Mr. G. M. Bhat as he was below to me in merit of interview/Selection through the P.S.C. as Superintendent ITI (Direct Quota) who now has been given the seniority w.e.f. 01-01-96 on notional basis even when he joined as Direct Recruit in 1999 and as Assistant Director/Principal (Jr. Scale)/ AAA ITI at appropriate place also in terms of the above mentioned facts and the circumstances of the case

OR

Mr. Bhat be placed at a seniority position below to me i.e. after 05-03-1999 as Superintendent ITI and as Assistant Director/Principal (Jr. Scale)/ AAA ITI also, so that I may not be deprived of benefits for seniority as superintendent

the matter:

"That the applicant has challenged the action of respondents after more than two decades as such the claim of the applicant/petitioner is time barred and can be contested before the Hon'ble Court/Tribunal on this ground also. The GAD in its circular No. 41-JK(GAD) of 2021 dated 06.10.2021 has also issued instruction for disposal of time barred representations/applicants etc. regarding service matters, it has been instructed not to entertain stale/time barred claims and close all such cases which cannot be resolved on account of inordinate delay.

In view of the above position, the attention of the department is invited towards the circular instructions of GAD dated 06.10.2021, and to advice them to file objection in the matter and also contest the matter on all available grounds before the Hon'ble Tribunal. The Department shall also recommend the name of some competent and well versed officer with the facts of the case for appointment of OIC in the matter."

Besides, the Hon'ble CAT Jammu branch disposed off the OA No. 61/621/2023 titled "Mr. Rajendra Kumar vs Principal Secretary SDD & Ors. on 04/07/2023 with the following order:

"After arguing the matter for some time, learned counsel for the applicant submitted that he may be permitted to withdraw the present original application with liberty to file contempt petition.

Accordingly, the original application is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforementioned."

Hence the grievance/claim of Mr. Rajendra Kumar considered and seems devoid of merit.

to me and have managed their regularization with the help of concerned officers ignoring their actual date of placement as in-charge superintendents under a stop gap arrangement. Shri A.R. Sheikh & Shri Mandeep Dogra were placed as incharge Superintendent on Stop gap vide order no: 115-edu(Tech) of 2003 Dated 15-09-2003. But there were no posts available at that point of time to department. Again Order No: 91 of 2004 Dated 15-09-2003 and Order no: 22-Edu (Tech) of 2004 dated 20-01-2004 except Abdul Rashid Sheikh Supervisor, being out of Department.

The proposal for the regularization of stopgap arrangement officers of the Skill Development Department has already been sent to the Public Service Commission under your No DSD/111/07/2023/02 dated 13/03/2022 but unfortunately, my name has not been included in the

In case a candidate from Category (a) is not available then eligible candidate from category (b) shall considered and vice-versa. In case candidates from category (b) are also not available then candidates from category (c) shall be considered.

24 incumbents under direct recruitment (50% of cadre strength) were existing in the department While against 50% promotion quota since 1992 onwards till the conduct of recent DPC-2023 50 eligible incumbents from the feeding category posts had been placed as I/c Supdt. from time to time but was not considered for regularization due to one or another reason. These incumbents agitated for the same through different mediums and also agitating to finalize the seniority of Superintendents after their confirmation, because direct recruits have been appointed in the department in the year Year 2004 , 2010 & 2013.

While incumbents among the feeding service category have been placed against the available post of Superintendent under promotion quota before their appointment viz since 1992 onwards but didn't considered for regularization despite clear vacancies under promotion quota. For the purpose some of the incumbents also approached Hon'ble court praying for their confirmation before finalizing the seniority of Superintendents.

More so there were also 19 incumbents who had been placed Assistant Aprt. Advisor/Asst. Director Training and Principal ITI, since 1980 to 2005 as per notified seniority in the year 2002, but these incumbents had also not been considered for promotion/regularization. Despite the fact that among these incumbents 14 incumbents have already been retired/deceased and only 5 such officers are on the establishment of the department. All these 19 incumbents were holding the post of Supdt. ITI on substantive basis and these posts can be accrued only after DPC/PSC clears their proposals to pave a way for regularization of I/c Superintendents under promotion quota.

Since, it was not possible/feasible for the department to address the grievance/finalize the seniority of Superintendents of ITIs on the basis of 50:50 ratio until and unless claim for regularization of I/c Superintendents under promotion quota in terms of existing recruitment rules and to satisfy the court orders in the case titled Mr. Sajad Naqueeb vs State titled SWP 821/2014 followed by contempt No. 560 of 2014, which has arrived at the stage of contempt, the operative part court order of Hon'ble Court is as below:

"So-viewed, the writ petition is disposed of with a

said list owing to the fact that the name of some juniors has been included in the above-said List ignoring my claim for regularization and further promotion as deputy director. This is in gross violation of the above-said court orders and warrants your kind attention in this regard to do justice with me by sending my proposal for regularization as Assistant Director and further promotion as Deputy Director in the Skill Development Department for which I have been requesting for the last 10 years. I am enclosing a copy of the Central Administrative Tribunal Srinagar order No. C.P./78/2023 (Srinagar) in TA/43/2022 regularization dated 24/06/2023 for further necessary action in your office. I hope that your kind self will consider claim for the above-cited purpose pending in the department for the last decade.

This resulted in regularization of junior supervisor/surveyors,

direction to the respondents to accord consideration to petitioner's promotion as Superintendent ITI on substantive basis, having regard to the averment made in the petition, annexure appended thereto and rules occupying the field. The respondents are expected to appreciate that right to be considered for promotion is an integral part of fundamental rights guaranteed under Article 16 constitution of India. The respondents by avoiding to consider petitioners claim and that too for last two decades are acting in violation of letter and spirit of the constitution and the recruitment rules. The respondents in any case shall complete the exercise within eight weeks from date of receipt of copy of this order and convey the decision to the petitioner so as to enable him to work out his remedy in the event his claim or any part thereof remains to be dealt with'

Moreover, it is to mention that Mr. Ab. Rashid Sheikh and Mr. Mandeep Dogra were eligible and placed against the post of Superintendent when Ms. Tawheeda Habib was not appointed/existing in the department as she has been appointed on 20.02.2004 , the service particulars of Mr. Mandeep & Mr. A.R Sheikh are as under:

SWP/1661 dated 23-09-2019 read with CAT orders dated 16-11-2022.

It is requested to kindly look into the matter in light of the above circumstances with regard to regularization of superintendents vide Govt order no: 69-JK(DSD) of 2023 dated 08-06-2023 and issue a revised seniority list wherein I am properly placed at S.No. 01 above the officials mentioned in the seniority list of superintendents of ITII

different reserved categories have been left in a lurch percolating into an uncanny situation with the officers falling under reserved categories stuck at the Superintendent ITI level only, since the inception of the Department.

At the time of the Revised Seniority List of Superintendent it is as on 01.01.2022 issued vide Circular no:04-JK(GAD) of 2022 Dated 15.11.2022 we had submitted a joint representation before the kind authority of worthy Principal Secretary Skill Development Department for inclusion of the reserved category as the designated slots as per the elaborated Govt instructions issued vide Circular No. 10-JK(GAD) of 2021 Dated 05.03.2021. However, the Seniority list issued is portraying an altogether different picture and is in contrast with the genuine demands embodied in the afforested representation.

We have







been appointed vide Govt Order No;92-Edu (Tech) of 2010 Dated: 14-05-2010 as Superintendent ITI under various reserved categories following recommendation of J&K Public Service Commission. In the year 2013, we became eligible for elevation to next higher post after completion of the qualifying service period of three years as the Superintendent ITI level. We have been making representation right from the year 2013 for placement against existing suitable higher post but unfortunately to no avail. Instead, three Superintendent it is were promoted/placed to higher posts in the year 2013 under Open Category without considering category based officers despite of their eligibility at that time. It is not out of the context to mention here that a number of departments including GAD J&K also promoted officers/officials under reserved category during that period.

In the above referred, latest notified Seniority

	list no mention has been made of the relevant Reserved Category under which we have been selected and appointed in the Department., even through a different yardstick has been chosen that category is mentioned against of few and the rest are ignored deliberately who fall under the reserved categories.

Whereas, while taking comprehensive view on the related court cases, before issuance of final seniority, SLO of the Department observed/opined that there is no any interim/stay order in issuing the seniority list of the superintendent cadre, as of now, as such, the Department may issue the final seniority list with the remarks that the same shall be subject to the outcome of writ petition(s), if any on the subject-matter. However, if the department feels any hesitation in issuing the seniority list under reference, the expert opinion from the department of Law, Justice & Parliamentary Affairs be obtained in the instant case, as the department is presently facing the contempt proceedings in various cases due to pending regularization of the respective cadre for which the updated seniority list is imperative at this stage; and
