Subject:- Report of the Committee constituted for HR/Physical Infrastructure of Audit courses offered at Government Polytechnics.

**Government Order No: 45 -JK(DSD) of 2022
Dated:12.05.2022**

Sanction is accorded to opening/introduction of one new branch/trades in Government Polytechnics in JKUT as recommended by Director Skill Development vide No.DSD/Poly/101/e-100306/45 dated 11.04.2022.

For this purpose, adequate land/infrastructure is already available in most of the Polytechnics and left over civil infrastructure is being completed in remaining polytechnics as well on war footing basis, as adequate funds have been released to Director, Skill Development for this purpose under CSS/CAPEX Budget. Similarly, adequate space is available in almost all new Polytechnics for introducing new courses except in Government Polytechnic colleges at Kupwara, Kishtwar, Doda and Ramban where regular academic blocks may be completed and machinery/equipment may be relocated/purchased within next few months against funds already released by Government for machinery & equipment, adequate funds have already been made available to Director, Skill Development released under CSS/CAPEX Budget.

Director, Skill Development Department shall ensure that the Principals of concerned Government Polytechnics apply online on AICTE portal for introduction of new branches/disciplines/trades in addition to those already introduced as per demand of students/feasibility and employability potential as per market demand for such courses including futuristic courses and ensure that applications are uploaded with complete details on AICTE portal and followed up with AICTE, New Delhi for approval well before next academic session in July, 2022.

Director Skill/Principals of Government Polytechnics are authorized to engage Guest/academic arrangement faculty as per trade/course needs in a transparent manner as per procedure in vogue, against vacant posts till regular faculty is appointed based on selection made by JKPSB/JKSSB.



Director, Skill Development shall ensure that all Principals of Polytechnics keep in view, recommendations of the manpower/infrastructure audit committee and interim recommendations of PwC while applying for new trades/courses in each Government Polytechnic, to offer greater choice to students and better employment opportunities and entrepreneurship skills, in a phased manner over next two years, with introduction of at least one new branch in each rural polytechnic in 16 Rural district Polytechnics, besides four old polytechnics located at Srinagar/Jammu and Polytechnics under administrative control of IUST and BGSBU, at Awantipora and Rajouri where additional branches have already been introduced for students.

Director, Skill Development and Secretary, JKBOTE shall ensure that 100% seats are filled up in all Government Polytechnics well before next academic session starting July, 2022 and local industry partnerships to ensure relevance of these courses for the job market as well as better entrepreneurship opportunities for youth within and outside J&K, in consonance with choice based credit system to be introduced in all Polytechnics as has been done at Awantipora and Rajouri Polytechnics
