Subject: Revision of the existing guidelines for the establishment of new Private ITIs in the UT of J&K.

**Government Order No.22-JK(DSD) of 2026**  
**Dated: 10.03.2026**

To address critical aspects related to the establishment of Private ITIs such as proximity criteria, relevance of proposed trades, minimum number of trades to be offered, and lack of clarity regarding land and infrastructure requirements, it is hereby ordered that the Technical Verification Committee, constituted vide Government Order No. 68-Edu (Tech) of 2018 dated 04.06.2018, shall:

1. Review and revise the existing guidelines for the establishment of new Private ITIs in the UT of Jammu & Kashmir, in line with the extant norms/guidelines of DGT/NCVT.
2. Review the functionality and relevance of existing trades and propose the introduction of new demand-driven trades in Government ITIs in accordance with the requirements of the new industrial framework.

The Committee shall be at liberty to co-opt any member(s) as deemed necessary and shall submit its report, along with specific recommendations taking into account all financial, infrastructural, and academic requirements, to the Administrative Department for examination, concurrence, and notification within 15 days from the date of issuance of this order.
