Sanction is hereby accorded to the post facto reimbursement of medical expenses incurred by Sh. Zubair Bashir, Junior Assistant Govt. ITI Baramulla, on treatment of his new-born son for congenital heart defect (Interrupted Aortic Arch-IAA with Large Inlet VSD with Perimembranous Extension), at Sir Ganga Ram Hospital New Delhi w.e.f 26-07-2025 to 31-07-2025, in terms of Rule 6 of the J&K Civil Services (Medical Attendance-Cum-Allowance) Rules, 1990.

The sanction is subject to following conditions:-

1. Reimbursement of charges shall be restricted to items/procedures admissible under rules and limited to the rates applicable to such items/procedures at AIIMS, New Delhi.
2. The claim shall be regulated to the extent the expenditure exceeds the package cost, if any, admissible under the AB-PMJAY SEHAT Scheme for the said treatment.
3. The Drawing & Disbursing Officer (DDO) shall confirm the applicable package under AB-PMJAY SEHAT Scheme from the State Health Agency (SHA).
4. All medical bills/vouchers shall be duly verified from the concerned hospital/medical authority where the treatment was undertaken.
5. Essentiality Certificate (Form-2) issued by the hospital authorities shall be obtained and kept on record.

6. Any follow-up treatment, if required, shall be regulated strictly under the relevant rules.
7. The expenditure shall be debitable to the appropriate Head of Account
