

They shall work in close coordination to get the schemes implemented on the ground level.

9. OSD, J&K Skill Development Mission, Jammu/ Srinagar

Terms of Reference (ToR) of the committee shall be:

1. To prepare skill development plans & roadmap for trainings/skilling of candidates identified under these schemes/programs by taking into consideration availability of infrastructure in terms of space, machinery & equipments, raw material available with the Department. Such modalities be also worked out for private institutions imparting skill trainings provided guidelines of the relevant scheme/program permit conducting such trainings through private institutions.
2. To examine whether the existing faculty of the Department cater to different training programs or otherwise and workout the additional requirements (if any).



3. To workout the financial requirements for conducting these trainings after taking into consideration (1) & (2) above, fund availability and guidelines of the schemes.
4. To examine the feasibility of creating skill centres at block level in coordination with education department and other line departments under overall guidance of DCs (Chairman, District Skill Committees).
5. To identify potential risks and challenges that may arise during the implementation and proposal mitigation strategies.
6. The committee shall submit a detailed implementation plan within one month.


