Skill Strengthening for Industrial Value Enhancement (STRIVE)

- Under this scheme, 07 ITIs and one industrial cluster are covered.
- 04 IT Labs, 7 ICT Labs have been established and capacity building of 355 officers done under the scheme.









Up-gradation of existing ITIs into Model ITIs

- The up-gradation of Srinagar ITI into Model ITI is being done at the cost of Rs. 10.00 crore. The funds are provided not only for up-gradration of infrastructure but also for procuring latest tools/equipments/ machinery required for introduction of new trades/ up-gradation of existing trades.
- The scheme will help in increasing overall seat utilization, improvement in pass out rate, placement, increase in wages of placed candidates, conduct of various short term courses.










Introduction of Online Admissions

- Online admission process started in all ITIs (Govt./Pvt.) from the academic session 2019-20 onwards. From academic session 2019-20 all admission forms are received in online mode only. During 2023, over 50,000 online applications have been received.
- Admission scenario in polytechnics improved and achieved the target of almost 100% admission in last three academic sessions i.e 2021-22, 2022-23 and 2023-24.

Development of credit based curriculum in accordance with NEP-2020 in polytechnics

First of its kind exercise undertaken in the country to develop curriculum in accordance with NSQF guidelines and as per NEP-2020 for AICTE approved Three Year Diploma Courses in UT of Jammu & Kashmir.

The Exercise has been taken up to encourage innovation, Flexibility, soft skills and communication skills. This Curriculum is: -

- Aligned with NEP-2020 & NSQF Guidelines.
- Having Credit based system.
- Allows Multi point entry and exit.
- With Provision for mobility wherever possible.
- Also having provision of basket of electives in allied and non-allied courses in engineering and non -engineering.

First of its kind Exercise undertaken in the country to develop Curriculum in accordance with NSQF Guidelines and as per NEP-2020 for AICTE approved Three year Diploma Courses in UT of Jammu & Kashmir.


Creation of Centers for Invention, Innovations, Incubation & Trainings (CIIIT).

- To facilitate innovation and entrepreneurship, we have established two cutting-edge Centers for Invention, Innovation, Incubation & Training (CIIIT) in collaboration with TATA Technologies at Government Polytechnics in Jammu and Baramulla at the whopping cost of Rs. 406.00 crore.
- Each CIIIT houses nine competency centers, focusing on key areas such as Innovation Design & Incubation, Product Verification Analysis, Product Lifecycle Management, Value Engineering & Benchmarking, Autonomous Connected Electrified, Mechatronics & IoT, Digital Manufacturing, Manufacturing Execution System, and Advanced Manufacturing Engineering.
- 27 MoUs have been signed with various industry partners for optimum utilization of CIIITs. 151 placement s have been made till date.



Centre of Excellence

- With the aim that skill imparted must keep pace with technological demands of the industry, two Centers of Excellence in Automobile sector have been established at Government ITI Kathua & Badgam in collaboration with Hinduja Group Ashoke Leyland.
- The centers cater to 27 ITI's where Automobile related training is being imparted with intake capacity of 800 trainees. Shree Rajeev Chandershekhar, honorable union minister of state, recently visited ITI Badgam and Polytechnic Ramban during the public outreach program and appreciated the working of the department.











Establishment of new ITI's

• 01 new Govt. ITI has been established in 2022 at Padder, Kishtwar, besides 07 new private ITIs have been established, 2 in 2021, 3 in 2022 and 2 in 2023 till date.

- Infrastructure such as workshop blocks, latest machinery and equipments and Hostel facilities created across UT, J&K in different Skill Institutions.
- Construction of all new Polytechnics within original scope of work to be completed during the current financial year.
- ▶ 5372 Women Self Help Groups have been trained in collaboration with National Rural Livelihood Mission. 1848 are under training.
- Training of tribal women and backward classes also completed.

Skill hubs have been established to provide skill development and vocational training opportunities to school dropouts and out of education candidates. Till now, 24 no. of ITIs were registered as Nodal Skill Hubs on Skill India Portal (PMKVY 3.0) and imparted skill training to 683 no. of candidates. Under pilot phase of PMKVY 4.0, 1775 no. of candidates have been enrolled by 38 Govt ITIs. Out of which 1383 candidates have completed the training in these institutions.







Capacity Building

 Conducted Capacity building of staff and students of Polytechnics in collaboration with prestigious institutions like IIT, Jammu and IIM, Jammu.

Ranking of ITI's

- Skill Development Department, J&K has undertaken a significant initiative to enhance the quality of ITIs across the UT of J&K. This pioneering effort involves the comprehensive grading of ITIs using key parameters. This grading system not only sets a "benchmark for comparison" among these institutes but also serves as a powerful tool for recognizing top-performing institutions. Additionally, it provides an invaluable opportunity for institutes that may be struggling in some areas to improve. The scoring process is meticulously conducted against each of the well-defined parameters.
- In summary, the department's achievement lies in its visionary project that aims to elevate the standards of ITIs, foster healthy competition, and foster continuous improvement among institutes based on clear, measurable criteria.



- District Skill Development Plans have been prepared and uploaded on SANKALP MSDE, GoI Portal.
- Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana 4.0 is expected to be launched soon by MSDE GoI. During pilot phase, targets have been allocated to IUST, NIELIT, PMKKs, NIESBUD, ITIs, AICTE approved colleges, sector skill councils, schools, JNVs, hospitals and some private institutions with a good standing by MSDE, GOI to NSDC.

FOOD CRAFT INSTITUTE, JAMMU

Courses Offered

- 1. The institute has conducted 1½ year Diploma programmes affiliated with National Council for Hotel Management and Catering Technology (NCHMCT), Noida, Ministry of Tourism Govt. of India in the following trades since 2017-18 in the new campus at Bamyal Morh NH44 Nagrota, Jammu.
 - i. Food Production
 - ii. Food & Beverage Service
 - iii. Front office operation
 - iv. Housekeeping Operation
 - v. Bakery & Confectionery
- 2. Apart from it the institute is conducting Short term Programmes of one month, three month & four months duration.
- 3. As regards training and placement of students undergoing one and half year diploma course in the institute, the institute has tied up with various five star hotels across the country for conduct of IT and placement of the students. The students have been selected after various round of interview with their HR teams and perhaps amongst the very few FCI's in the country who have tied up with various five star hotels across the country on such a large scale.

Major Achievements - FCI

As regards conduct of Short Term Skill Training Programmes, such programmes are being conducted by the institute at various destinations in the UT like Katra, Bhaderwah, Reasi, Samba, Rajouri, Kupwara, Banihal etc as per the guidelines of Ministry of Tourism, GoI, which are sponsored by MOT GOI. The institute has also tied up with Indian Army at Kupwara and Jammu Cantonment for conduct of training programmes for the unemployed youth of the area who are being motivated by the Indian army to undergo skill training being conducted by FCI Jammu and help them in placements in Kashmir as well as other parts of the country. The institute showcased a diverse array of forest-sourced ingredients through a delightful range of recipes.
- FCI Jammu has tied up with J&K Prisons Department for training of jail inmates in Kot Bhalwal Central Jail Jammu which would serve twin purpose i.e. to meet up with the Bakery requirement of Jail Inmates in house production & secondly the jail inmates can attain skill in field of Bakery which would help them in their livelihood after their release.
- FCI Jammu has entered an MoU with J&K Police PHQ Jammu on 10-04-2023 to train the next of kin of martyrs of J&K Police in various trade of Food Production, Food & Beverages, and Front Office as per the guidelines of Ministry of Tourism, Govt. of India (Short term Skill Training Programmes) and help them place in the Hotel Industry across the country.

The conduct of 3 years degree course & admitting students on All India Basis with in house hostels & added laboratories shall make the institute self sufficient in times to come.

- **ADMISSIONS:** Admissions are done by JKBOTE for 26 government/Private Polytechnics Colleges of UT of J&K and Ladakh
- **EXAMINATION:** Two exams are conducted each year for the Polytechnic colleges.
- ▶ Engineering /Non-Engineering Branches for the sessions: May-June and Nov-Dec in which 13- 15 thousand students appear. An annual examination is conducted each year for the ITIs under the scheme SCVT. Results are declared by JKBOTE for both Polytechnics and ITI's of UT of J&K and Ladakh
- **CERTIFICATION**: Certificates are provided to the candidates of Polytechnics as well ITIs
